Where as it is Credibly Reported that Majo^r John -
Levingston m^r Samuel Rogers and some other perfons
have Lately purchafed some Lands of oweneca within
the Late Adition to this Towneship which is contrary to
Law: it being the undoubted Righte of this Towne & no --
other perfon what soever to buy or hire any of sd Land of
the Indians: This Towne therefore see Cause to make Choice
of m^r James Rogers Junio^r Joshua Hempsteed and m^r Stephen
Prentice to Complaine of and profecute the perfons above
saide In the behalfe of: and at the Charge of this Towne for
theire breach of Law in above premifes: and any others tha^t
have unlawfully Bought or hired any Lands within the
Bounds above saide: sinc it was ordered to this Towne
shipt

The above Comittee are hereby farther Impowred to profe
-cute: or Anfwer at Any Generall Courts in the Collony Con
cerning the Premifes or any other Actt or thing that hath
been Done that they shall Judge A predgiduce to y^e Towne
In that affaire: Either of each of them Sufficent to app^r
eare in any Courte Concerning the premifes
