To the Sheriff of ye County of New London his Deputy or to Either of y<sup>e</sup> Conftables of y<sup>e</sup> Town of Norwich, within Said County Greeting,  
Whereas Sam Alhpo, and his wife Hannah, and Thankfull Ashpo all Indians Belonging to Moheagen, in the Town & County of New London, have before me the Subscriber one of his majestys Justices of y<sup>e</sup> Peace for f<sup>d</sup> County, accused M.<sup>rs</sup> ~ Elizabeth Goodhew, the Wife of M.<sup>r</sup> Jonathan Goodhue of S.<sup>d</sup> Norwich, and Say that the Said Elizabeth Goodhue, did in Norwich afors.<sup>d</sup> on y<sup>e</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> of may ~ Infant, at y<sup>e</sup> Dwelling house of y<sup>e</sup> s.<sup>d</sup> Jonathan Goodhue Sell & deliver one Quart of Cyder to an Indian Woman which was then & There present in f.<sup>d</sup> Norwich, against the Peace of our Sovereign Lord y<sup>e</sup> King his Crown & Dignity, and against y<sup>e</sup> form & Effect of one Statute Law of This Colony in this Colony Law-Book page 95: Entitled, an act, for well order: =ing, and Governing the Indians in this Colony; and Securing their Interests, and Lands therein.

In his Majesty's Name you are Comanded to arreft y<sup>e</sup> s.<sup>d</sup> Elizabeth Goodhue (if to be found in your Precincts) and her bring before me the Subscriber at the Town houfes in f.<sup>d</sup> Norwich on the 20:<sup>th</sup> day of may Instant at one of y<sup>e</sup> Clock afternoon, then & There to answer the Premises and to be Delt with as to Law & Justice Shall be found to appertain, and you are like wise Comanded to Summons and Give Notice to the s.<sup>d</sup> Jonathan Good hue of y<sup>e</sup> Time & Place of Tryal that he may be present (if he Sees Causes to Defend in y<sup>e</sup> Cafe above Said, Hereof Fail Not, and make due Return according to Law, Dated in Norwich this 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1758.
