

The Deed of Sale from the Indians for the plantation at
thirty Mile Island

This writing made the twentieth Day of ^v May one thousand Six hundred Sixty and two between Towkiske Sashus quatamampum Suponemo pampooffeme Keaway-tahue and Turramug and Nabahuit of y^e one party and M^r Matthew Allyn and M^r Samuel Willis ^vone y^e other part witnesseth that the afore said Towkiske Sashus

quatamampum Sepunnemoe pampo^offemee Keawaytahue, Turramugus & Nabahuit for divers good Considerations them moving there unto hath Granted and bargained and sold and by these prevents Doth Grant bargain and Sell to and with the afore said Gentlemen all the Land from Mattabezit mill River to the Lower End of pattaquonk Meadow on both sides of the great River Six Miles breadth into the Country of Each side the great River the whole Length afore said Except thirty mile Island and forty acres of Land at Pattaquonk which they do Reserve for of y^e afore Said bounds for to have and to holdall ye afore said Land Except y^e before Excepted to them and their A^signs from y^e day of the Date here ^of for ever with out any interruption or Molestation from any other English or Indians Claim ing Right by from or under ~~us~~ them assureing them that we have not made any Gift or Sale of any of the afore Said Land and that we have Lawfull Right to Sell the same, Memorandum we do reserve to our selves free liberty to hunt and fish & our other Roalty in the afore said land at our pleasure; So we abuse not nor wrong the English in their Cattell or Corn, Further we fell to y^e afore S^d Gentle men all y^e trees Stone Mines Minerals ponds brooks Rivers Lyeing or being with in the afore said parcel of Land and for y^e Confirmation of all and Every of the premises we firmly bind our Selves our heirs Executors as Witnesses our hands the day and year above said, Towkiske and her Children is allowed for their part in ye afore said purchase ten Coats, Turramugus and Nabahuit and their Children are allowed for their part in y^e afore S^d purchase ten Coats, where as it is said that the bounds of the Land Shall be at Mattabezett Mill River and on both sides of the great River Six Miles into y^e Country of Each Side of y^e great River now it is agreed that on y^e East Side of y^e great River the bounds Shall begin at y^e Straits and to Run into the Country Six miles breadth all y^e afore S^d length to pattaquonk Captain Cullets Land only Excepted, Sepunnemoe pampoofome Keawaytahue are allowed ten Coats for their parts in the afore said purchas for y^e Confirmation of y^e premises we Set to our hands the day and year above Said.
